RE: SB 94 – Veto Request

Dear Governor Schwarzenegger,

Campaign for Children and Families respectfully requests that you veto SB 94 (Kuehl).

SB 94 is a \$3.2 million money grab that will largely go to Planned Parenthood, which opposes logical reforms such as parental notification and basic safety standards for abortion clinics.

A large portion of the \$3.2 million in the bill will very likely be controlled by Planned Parenthood, which is already well funded and spent around \$10 million against Prop. 73 in 2005 and Prop. 85 in 2006. Planned Parenthood abortion clinics are already on record violating California's mandatory reporting laws in numerous cases of statutory rape (Source: www.childpredators.com/Tapes.cfm).

Governor, while many Californians may call themselves "pro-choice" on abortion, most Californians are conflicted on tax-funding of abortions. Even more conflicting is the issue of tax-funded abortions for minors, without parental notification, without limit per calendar year, and with complete disregard for California's mandatory reporting and statutory rape laws.

Please veto SB 94. Taxpayer funds of this magnitude should never go to a controversial, political operation.
